

Getting to Cardiff High School Old Boy RFC

Hopefully you will all be prepared for your trip to Cardiff. We look forward to welcoming you for the weekend to our rugby club. To help you to arrive please find attached some simple instructions on how to get to the rugby club which is located in the north part of Cardiff.

By Road (See Map below)

From West Wales (Fishguard, Pembroke, Swansea)

Leave the M4 at junction 32 Coryton. Take the 5th exit off the roundabout onto the A4054 (Pendwyallt Road) heading towards Whitchurch. This leads onto Park Road. At the first roundabout take the 4th and last exit onto Velindre Road. Follow Velindre Road passing straight over the mini roundabout until the road drops down a short hill. Bear right at the fork onto Forest Farm Road. Follow this road past the entrances to the housing estates and the rugby club will appear on the right hand side. There is a carpark to the front and the back of the clubhouse. Park up and contact the clubhouse steward in the main building.

From the East (Newport, Bristol, Birmingham, London)

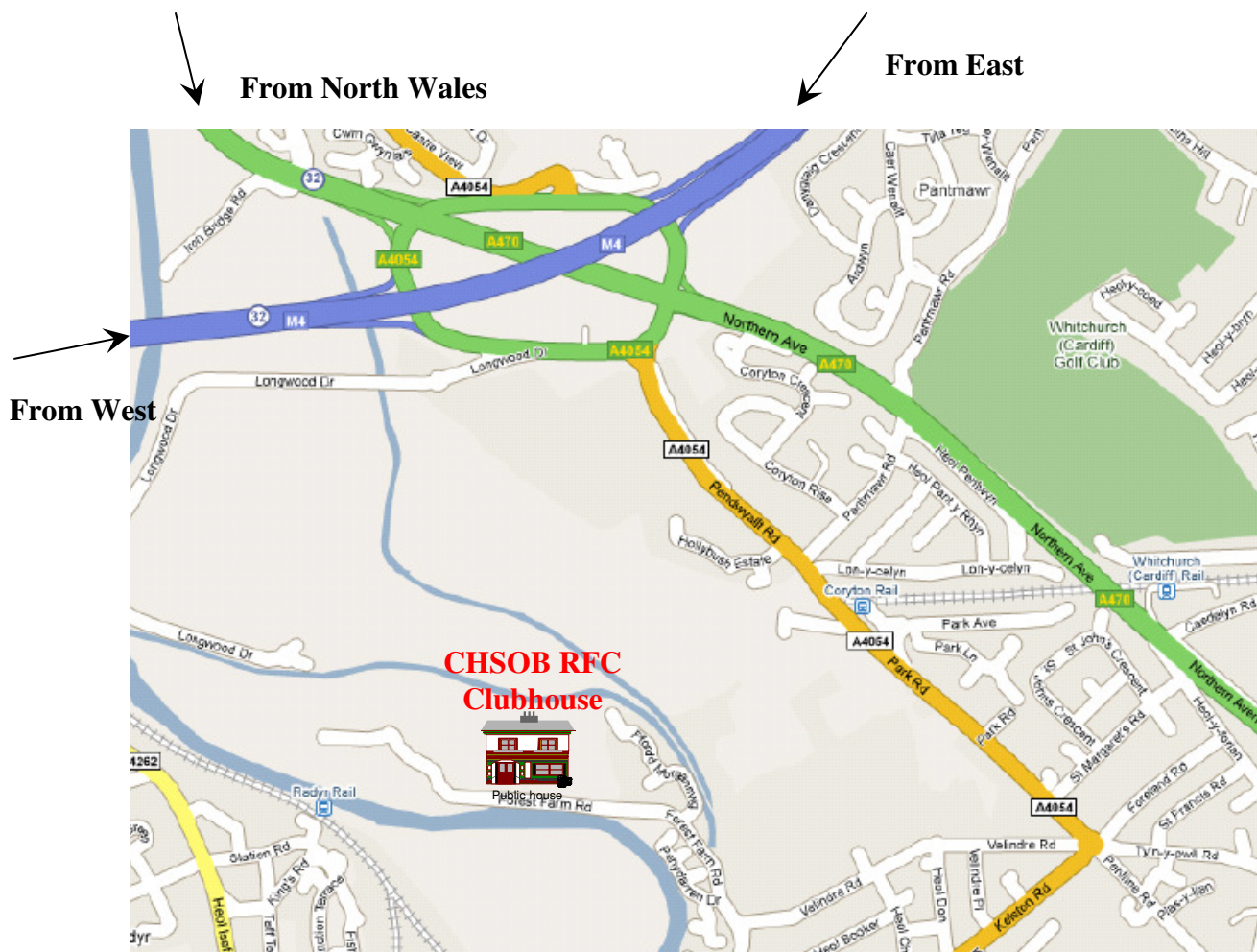
Leave the M4 at junction 32 Coryton. Take the 2nd exit off the roundabout onto the A4054 (Pendwyallt Road) heading towards Whitchurch. Follow the instructions above from West Wales to the club.

From North Wales.

If you are coming through the middle of Wales follow the A470 down to Cardiff. Once you pass beneath the M4 at junction 32 take the next left at the first set of Traffic Lights. Whitchurch Golf Club

is on the left hand side of the junction. Proceed down Pantmawr Road until the T junction. Turn right onto Park Road and at the first roundabout take the Velindre Road exit. Follow the instruction above to get to the clubhouse and grounds.

Note: If you are not sure about directions once in the UK use a route planner like Google Maps. Our postcode is CF14 7JH. That should bring you all the way to our door.



By Train

If you are coming by train to Cardiff, change at Cardiff Central Station. You will require a train heading to Radyr. (They usually depart from platform 6 or 7) Get off the train at Radyr and using the bridge cross over onto the platform furthest away from the car park. Exit the platform and at the bottom of the steps, turn left and cross over the river. Once on the other side turn right and

walk down the path way. **NOTE: This path is not very well lit and if you are arriving at night it is best to have a torch!**

The path joins onto Forest Farm road and, keeping the river on your right, walk about 100m further. The Clubhouse and grounds will be on the left hand side of the road.

By Bus

If you are arriving by bus to the city centre bus station besides to Cardiff Central Railway Station and follow the instructions for the train above. You need a ticket to Radyr Station. The nearest bus stop to the club is further away than train station!

By Plane

If you are flying into Cardiff, Bristol or any other airport the easiest (and cheapest) way to get to us is again get transport such as a train or bus to Cardiff Bus Station. Then get the train from the central railway station to Radyr.
